

SA MINIATURE HORSE SHOW CLASSES 2017

Competitors must ensure that they are correctly registered with the South African Miniature Horse Breeders Society. Temporary Show Membership is available and compulsory for ALL NOT registered with the society at a cost of R200 per miniature horse. This temporary membership allows you to enter all the classes from class 43 to class 82. Contact ronande@studbook.co.za for temporary show membership. (R200 per horse) Geldings don't need temporary membership. **Geldings Free in all classes.**

1. Group of three mares – any age. Must belong to the same owner
2. Best Pair – Stallion and Mare – both animals to belong to the same owner.
3. Mare with **two** of her progeny, any gender not necessarily the property of the same owner
4. Stallion with **two** of his progeny, any gender not necessarily the property of the same owner.
5. **Three** of the progeny of a stallion, any gender not necessarily the property of the same owner.
6. **Three** of the progeny of a mare, any gender not necessarily the property of the same owner
7. Senior Base Mare older than 3 years above 95cm and up to and including 100cm.
8. Mare with foal at foot (max age of foal 6 months).
9. Filly under 6 months of age – may not exceed 80cm.
10. Colt under 6 months of age – may not exceed 80cm.
11. Filly 6 to 12 months old – may not exceed 84cm.
12. Colt 6 to 12 months old – may not exceed 80cm
13. Filly 12 to 18 months old – may not exceed 90cm.
14. Colt 12 to 18 months old – may not exceed 86cm.
15. Filly 18 to 24 months old – may not exceed 90cm.
16. Colt 18 to 24 months old – may not exceed 88cm.
17. Junior Mare 24 to 36 months – may not exceed 95cm.
18. Junior Stallion 24 to 36 months – may not exceed 90cm.
19. Junior Mare 36 to 48 months - may not exceed 95cm.
20. Junior Stallion 36 to 48 months – may not exceed 90cm.
21. Senior Mare older than 4 years higher than 90cm but not exceeding 95cm in height.
22. Senior Stallion older than 4 years higher than 85cm but not exceeding 90cm in height.
23. Senior Mare older than 4 years higher than 85cm but not exceeding 90cm in height.
24. Senior Stallion older than 4 years higher than 80cm but not exceeding 85cm in height.
25. Senior Mare older than 4 years higher than 80cm but not exceeding 85cm in height.
26. Senior Stallion older than 4 years higher than 75cm up to and including 80cm in height.
27. Senior Mare older than 4 years higher than 75cm but not exceeding 80cm in height.
28. Senior Stallion older than 4 years higher than 70cm up to and including 75cm in height.
29. Senior Mare older than 4 years 75cm and smaller.
30. Senior Stallion older than 4 years 70cm and smaller.
31. Best Gelding from 90cm up to and including 100cm
32. Best Gelding smaller than 90cm
33. **CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION FILLY** - (1st and 2nd placing classes 9 and 11)
34. **CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION COLT** – (1st and 2nd placings classes 10 and 12)
35. **JUNIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION MARE** (1st and 2nd placing classes 13, 15, 17, and 19)

36. **JUNIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION STALLION** (1st and 2nd placing classes 14, 16, 18, and 20.)
37. **SENIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION MARE** (1st and 2nd placing classes 21, 23, 25, 27, and 29.)
38. **SENIOR CHAMPION AND RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION STALLION.** (1st and 2nd placing classes 22, 24, 26, 28, and 30.)
39. **CHAMPION GELDING AND RESERVE CHAMPION GELDING** (1ST and 2nd placing classes 31 and 32)
40. **GRAND CHAMPION AND RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION MARE.** (Champion and Reserve Champion in classes 33, 35 and 37)
41. **GRAND CHAMPION AND RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION STALLION.** (Champion and Reserve Champion in classes 34, 36 and 38)
42. **SUPREME CHAMPION MINIATURE HORSE AND RESERVE SUPREME CHAMPION MINIATURE HORSE** (Champions and Reserve Champions in classes 40 and 41)
43. Mare solid colour any age (60% colour ; 40% conformation)
44. Stallion and/or Gelding solid colour any age (60% colour ; 40% conformation)
45. Mare multi colour any age (60% colour ; 40% conformation)
46. Stallion or Gelding multi colour any age (60% colour ; 40% conformation)
47. Mare - Appaloosa colour. Solid or Broken. Any age (60% colour ; 40% conformation) No Cross entries between classes 45 and 47)
48. Stallion or Gelding - Appaloosa colour. Solid or Broken. (60% colour ; 40% conformation) No cross entries between classes 46 and 48)
49. Presentation Driving – Single Harness. (Harness, dress and general impression)
50. Presentation Driving - Multiple Harness
51. Open drive - Single Harness.
52. Open drive - Multiple Harness.
53. Obstacle Driving – Single Harness. Penalties – time to come into play only when horses are tied for a place
54. Junior Driving Class. Driver to be 14 years to 18 years. Single Harness. Stallion Mare or Gelding. Competitors may compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 14 years of age until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 18 years of age.
55. Children’s Driving. Driver to be 6 years to 13 years. Competitors may compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 6 years of age until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 13 years of age. Single Harness. – mare or gelding. (May be accompanied by an adult)
56. Ladies Driving - Single Harness.
57. Ladies driving - Multiple harness.
58. Long reining – horse to negotiate a series of obstacles in long reins. Open.
59. Senior Obstacle class – handler to be older than 18 years. Horse to negotiate a series of obstacles in hand on leading rein.
60. Junior Obstacle class – handler to be between 10 to 18 years of age. Competitors may compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 10 years of age until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 18 years of age. Horse to negotiate a series of obstacles in hand on a leading rein.
61. Child Obstacle Class. Competitors may compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 4 years of age until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 9 years of age. Competitors may be accompanied by an adult. Horse to negotiate a series of obstacles in hand on leading rein.

62. Best Turned out Horse and **Rider** - stallion, mare or gelding.
63. Best Child Rider - stallion, mare or gelding.
64. Best Turned out Horse and **Handler**.
65. Best Child handler under the age of 8 years (Children must be dressed neatly in pants, shirt and shoes. Hats and gloves are to be worn.) Child may be accompanied by an adult and assisted by attaching a 2nd lead rein to the horse.
66. Best Child handler 8 years to 14 years of age. (Children must be dressed neatly in pants, shirt and shoes. Hats and gloves are to be worn)
67. Stallion by Breeder showing for the 1st time.
68. Mare by Breeder showing for the 1st time.
69. Smallest Horse – only senior horses above the age of 3 years. Judged on conformation 40% and height 60%. Judges point horses on conformation out of a maximum point of 10
70. Best mare from an **unregistered breeder** any age up to and including a height of 100cm.
71. Best stallion from an **unregistered breeder** any age up to and including a height of 90cm.
72. Best Groom Handler. (Entries Free.)
73. Costume class
74. Novice Show Jumping – Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. Height of horse up to and including 80 cm and smaller. Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. No cross entries between Novice and Open classes.
75. Novice Show Jumping – Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. Height of horse taller than 80 cm up to and including 90cm in height. Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. No cross entries between Novice and Open classes.
76. Novice Show Jumping – Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. Height of horse taller than 90cm up to and including 100cm. Horses never been placed first in jumping competition. No cross entries between Novice and Open classes.
77. Open Show jumping. Horses up to and including 80 cm and smaller. No cross entries between class Novice and Open Classes.
78. Open Show Jumping. Height of horse taller than 80 cm up to and including 90cm in height. No cross entries between Novice and Open classes.
79. Open Show Jumping. . Height of horse taller than 90cm up to and including 100cm. No cross entries between Novice and Open classes.
80. Power Jump – Horses up to and including 80 cm and smaller. Only one obstacle.
81. Power Jump – Horses taller than 80 cm up to and including 90cm in height. Only one obstacle.
82. Power Jump – Horses taller than 90 cm up to and including 100cm in height. Only one obstacle.

The show organiser together with the council is allowed to combine or to split up any classes at their discretion at any given time.

NB - An award will be given for the Horse with the BEST MOVEMENT. At the discretion of the judge/s
